SITE	The Balfour Natatorium is an 8-lane, 25-yard pool with 6-foot-wide lanes and non-turbulent lane lines. The 5 lane x 20 yard warm down pool is adjacent to the main pool. The timing system includes a fully-automatic Colorado Timing Systems electronic timing system with touchpads at the finish end of the pool with multi-line electronic display. There are no touchpads at the turn end of the pool. The finish end of the pool is 6 feet deep; the turn end of the pool is 12 feet deep. Spectator seating is for 250. The pool is located inside the Wheaton College Haas Athletic Facility. Directions may be found later in this document.

FORMAT:	• The meet will be swum as a mix of trials/finals and timed finals. All events are trials/finals except for relays and any distance events 400 yards and over, which will be swum timed finals. <u>Trials/Finals Format</u> • Trials/Finals prelim events will be circle seeded slow to fast. • 12&Under events will have 1 Final for each Trials/Finals event. 12&Unders will NOT be separated depending on sub age group (ex. 10&Under), for both prelims or finals. • 13&Over events will have 4 Finals for each Trials/Finals event. The “D Final”, will be protected to 13-14 athletes. 13&Over sub age group athletes (ex. 13-14), will not be separated for prelims and will be seeded together. • Order of Finals: 12&U A Final → 13-14 D Final → 13&Over C Final → 13&Over B Final → 13&Over A Final • Each final contains 8 athletes. <u>Continued Format</u> • All relays will swim at finals. Relays will swim slow to fast. • All events 400&Over will be alternating heat by gender and will swim fast to slow. • The top heat for the 400 IM and 500 Free will swim at finals. • Athletes are able to request to swim the 400 IM or the 500 Free in the prelims session, by the evening 6:00 PM deadline, should they be projected to swim in the finals heat. • Swimmers can compete in a maximum of 3 individual events per day, including time trials. • There will be no scratch sheets. • No events will swim with more than one swimmer per lane.
SCRATCHES	There will no scratch sheets and all check in will be done at the admin table or online. • As of now, we are planning to utilize a digital scratch sheet with an online scratch form. More information will be available closer to the meet. • Thursday events will utilize a positive check in - athletes may check in at the admin table or online. • Prelim and timed finals events will have no penalty, should the athlete not scratch and not swim in their event. To limit the session time and improve the meet experience, please scratch your swimmer if they will not swim. • Prelims scratches will be due at 6:00 PM, the night before the session. • Finals Scratch/Penalty Policy: ○ Intents to scratch and scratches for finals will be due within 30 minutes of the results posting online, or the event results announcement over the PA, whichever comes last. A posting time will be available on the page. ○ Failure to compete in the finals round of a prelims/finals event, with no scratch, will result in the removal of any additional events the swimmer has. This includes all individual, relay, and time trial events. A \$100.00 penalty fee will apply if the athlete has no more registered events in the meet. This fee can also apply if the athlete does have more events in the meet, and would like to be reinstated in those events. This fee is payable at the admin table the host team. ○ Scratches from Finals will be conducted in accordance with articles 207.11.6D and 207.11.6E in the USA Swimming rules. ○ If a swimmer is not announced or posted as swimming in finals, and do end up in a finals round of a prelims/finals swim for any reason, they will not be subject to a penalty, should they not swim. ○ If you know you can’t swim at finals, please scratch!

ELIGIBILITY	● All swimmers must be currently registered as athlete members of USA Swimming (USAS) <i>before 5:00 pm on the day before the first day of the meet.</i> ● Age is determined by the age of the swimmer on the first day of the meet. ● Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS Member-Coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the Backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a Member-Coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. ● Coaches must be registered before the start of the meet. ● If a swimmer who is not properly registered with USAS competes in a sanctioned competition, the host LSC will impose <i>a fine of up to \$100.00 per event against the individual, member coach, or a member club</i> submitting the entry. ● Deck Registrations will NOT be accepted.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	● Athletes with a disability are welcome; they, or the athlete's coach, shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Entry Chair/Contact. ● The athlete, or the athlete's coach, is also responsible for notifying the Meet Referee of any disability prior to the competition.
ENTRY POLICY	100% Invitational ● The meet host may allocate 100% of splashes for the meet. ● 25% of the splashes allocated must be allocated to New England Swimming Teams, excluding the meet host. The meet host must make a reasonable effort at the time of allocation to solicit interest from New England Swimming teams. If no teams express interest at the time of allocation, the meet host may proceed with allocating these reserved splashes to out-of-LSC teams. ● If a specified allocation of splashes is granted to a team and agreed upon in writing between the meet host and attending team, the attending team is financially responsible for that allocation if unused, unless the meet host is able to substitute other participants to fill the unused splashes.
CUT PROTOCOL	If a session is over-subscribed, the Meet Director reserves the right to limit events, heats, swimmers, or adjust the format to conform to the 4-Hour Rule using the following Cut Protocols in any order deemed necessary: ● Teams may be asked to cut each athlete to no more than two fewer events per day than the maximum allowed. ● Entries may be cut by time, or to a specific number of heats, for specified events. ● Teams may be asked to cut relay events. ● If deck scratches allow a reasonable timeline, the swimmers can be reinstated into those previously entered events. Clubs will be notified of cuts no later than Monday before the meet.

ENTRIES	• Electronic entries should be emailed as an attachment to the Entry Chairperson. Please check that your team's name, address, and contact information are listed correctly in this file. For email entries, payment and online waiver must be received by 07/29/2026. Failure to pay Entry Fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet. • An online waiver will substitute the regular Entry Payment and Release Form. This will be sent out to coaches, upon first entry. • Make check payable to: Legacy Aquatics Mail CHECK ONLY to: Determination Aquatics 43 Indian Ridge Rd Natick, MA 01760 ATTN: LA-26AUG • Any team that fails to submit the Entry Payment and Waiver online form as well as payment by the aforementioned date may be scratched from the meet and may be assessed a \$100 fine at the discretion of the Entry Chairperson. If no payment is received after 30 days, the fine is doubled. This fine is payable to Legacy Aquatics. Late payment of entry fees may result in future exclusion from meets hosted by our club. • IMPORTANT: If payment is sent via Express Mail/FedEx/Airborne/UPS/etc., please ensure that a signature is NOT required for delivery. • Entries will be acknowledged within 48 hours if they are accepted into the meet. <i>Your entry is considered received only if you receive an acknowledgement.</i> • All Unattached swimmers must be declared as "Unattached" on the Entry Payment and Liability Release Form before the meet begins. • All Entry Times must be entered in the specified meet course. Coach's times may be used (and are preferred) instead of "NT" Entry Times. • Athletes may enter as many events as they choose but may only compete in a maximum of 6 individual events per day for timed final events. Time trials count in the per day event count. • ENTRY TIME UPDATES: Entry Times may be updated <i>until the Monday prior to the first day of the meet.</i> No new entries will be accepted after the Final Date of Entry Acceptance; they will be automatically excluded from Entry Time Update files. Entry Time Updates must be sent via email to the Entry Chairperson in Hy-Tek format. • No deck entries will be accepted.
TIME TRIALS	Time Trial events will be offered at the discretion of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.
RELAYS	• Dual Human Confirmation of relay take off violations will be required at all New England Swimming meets. • All relay swimmers must be officially entered into the meet. • Unattached swimmers may not participate in any relays. • Mixed relays must consist of four swimmers, two of each gender.

FEES	● Timed Final Individual Specialty Events (200-yards and under): \$5.00 ● Trials/Finals events \$10.00 ● Distance events (events 400 yards and over) \$10.00 ● Relay events: \$20.00 ● Time Trial events: \$10.00 for IE; \$40 for relays ● Per-Swimmer Participation Fee: \$25.00 ● Per-Swimmer NES Travel Fee: \$1.00 (to be included in the check sent by the host team to NES)
MEET MOBILE	MEET MOBILE HEAT SHEETS: Meet Mobile heat sheets will be offered at this meet for no charge. The Meet Mobile heat sheet includes smart phone access to all heat sheets for the whole meet, including last minute changes and re-seeds. MEET MOBILE: Meet Mobile will be functional for this meet, (dependent upon satisfactory internet access) All users should be aware that Meet Mobile publishes unverified raw data that may not always be accurate.
WARM-UP	Warm Up plans will be shared closer to the meet.
AWARDS	There will be no awards.
SCORING	The meet will not be scored.
LEGAL SPLITS	Individual Events: Preferably, Legal Splits should be requested before the event, by a coach, using a Legal Split Form (available from the Control Table), and the requesting party should supply an additional timer(s) on the lane for the split, if necessary, to ensure an accurate time (one timer with touchpad timing, three timers without touchpad timing). Timers must be positioned over the lane at the end of the racing course. Optionally, a Legal Split may be requested after the event using a Legal Split Form when using a fully automatic timing system. The Admin Official has discretion to either grant or deny the request after reviewing the available evidence. Backstroke Legal Splits must be requested in advance to ensure a legal finish. LEGAL SPLITS – Relays: All lead-off splits for relays are automatically loaded into SWIMS and do not require additional watches for validation unless there are no touchpads present, or the second swimmer starts in the water. If there are no touchpads, or the second swimmer starts in the water, a legal split form with three watches will be required for entry into SWIMS. Timers must be positioned over the lane at the end of the racing course. It is recommended that coaches report lead-off time discrepancies to the Administrative Referee or Administrative Official.
SWIMWEAR	Per USA Swimming rules (102.8.1.F), 12&Under swimmers may not wear a Technical Suit at any Sanctioned, Approved, or Observed meet. The age of the swimmer is determined on the first day of the meet. Guidance on identifying compliant and non-compliant suits can be found on the USA Swimming website under Tech Suit Restriction for 12-and-Under Swimmers .
RULES	● The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy (MAAPP 2.0) will govern this meet.

	● Operation of a DRONE, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USAS approval. ● Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>. ● PHOTOGRAPHY: As per NES policy, professional photographers contracted by M.F. Swimming, LLC, or press photographers who have been approved in advance by the Meet Director, are allowed on deck. ● Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted behind the starting blocks, including in any spectator area behind the starting blocks, nor in any other marked NO CAMERA ZONE, including on deck. All NO CAMERA ZONES will be clearly designated. Email the Meet Director with questions and requests. ● VIDEO STREAMING: All video streaming must be approved in advance by the Meet Director. Any such video stream must conform to all current SafeSport policies defined by USAS, NES, and the Meet Host. No video stream may originate from behind the starting blocks or from any other area marked as a NO CAMERA ZONE. ● Deck Changing is PROHIBITED. ● An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider. ● According to NES Best Practices, all athletes should shower before entering the pool. ● In accordance with NES Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USAS credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
SAFETY	● No shaving is permitted at the competition site. ● No glass containers are permitted within the facility. ● Swimmers must be under the supervision of a coach. If a swimmer arrives at the meet without a coach, the swimmer should notify the Meet Referee before he/she warms up, and the Meet Referee will assign the swimmer to a registered coach for warm-ups. ● Lifeguards will be on duty anytime an athlete is on deck. The facility is equipped with standard first aid and an AED. WARM UP SAFETY: ● Diving will be prohibited during warm-ups except in specifically announced one-way sprint lanes. There will be no diving in the warm-up and warm-down areas at any time. ● For all warm-up sessions, swimmers must utilize a “sit-and-slide”/“three-point” entry to enter the pool for warm-ups, by first sitting on the deck, and then sliding, feet-first, into the pool.

	● In extraordinary cases, due to bulkheads and other pool designs, it may be determined that it is unsafe or impossible for swimmers to perform the required sit and slide entry. In such extremely rare cases, the sit and slide rule may be modified. Exceptions to the sit and slide rule shall only be made when performing the sit and slide entry poses risk of injury to swimmers and/or risk damaging or ripping of swimsuits. An exception to the sit and slide rule shall only be made when the Safety Monitor, Meet Director, and Meet Referee have evaluated the risks and unanimously determined that the use of the sit and slide entry poses such great risk as to be unsafe. In these cases, the Safety Monitor, Meet Director, and Meet Referee must determine and agree upon an alternative safety plan to ensure swimmer safety.
SAFE SPORT	● The USA Swimming SafeSport program is USAS's comprehensive abuse prevention program dedicated to creating a healthy and positive environment free from abuse for all its members. Components of the program include, but are not limited to, providing education and training, enforcing policies (such as the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy), rules and best practice guidelines, promoting healthy boundaries and mandatory reporting of violations. ● The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits Adult Participants (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult participant. Adult Participants are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet. ● Pursuant to USAS Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 833-5US-SAFE (833-587-7233), or via online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency. ● For information on how to report other alleged violations, including without limitation the Code of Conduct found within the USAS Rules and Regulations as well as the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, please visit www.usaswimming.org/report. ● All athletes age 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. <i>Any athlete who turns 18 on or after August 6th, 2026, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed.</i> Times achieved by an athlete who turns 18 on or after <i>August 6th, 2026</i>, who competes in this USAS sanctioned event without completing this requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.
CHANGES TO MEET	Once a meet is sanctioned, changes can be made to the Meet Information before the meet only with the approval of the Co-Technical Chairs, Patrick Johnstone and Greg Gower. Any change to the Meet Format after the meet begins will be at the discretion of the Meet Referee, and will be presented to the coaches at a coaches meeting.
WEATHER/FACILITY PROTOCOL	If weather or facility conditions make it impossible to follow the original timeline of events, the Meet Director and Meet Referee have a right to make changes to the meet sessions. The Meet Director will notify the teams of the changes with as much notice as possible. Cancellation of the meet, or a session, is the decision of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, and the Meet Jury.

MEET JURY	The Meet Jury will be made up of one official, one coach, and one athlete to be selected by the Meet Referee who will present issues and moderate the Meet Jury but not vote. When possible, the three members shall be from separate teams. The Meet Jury will decide all issues of eligibility, and anything not addressed in the Meet Announcement. The Meet Referee shall have authority as described in the current USA Swimming Rulebook.
DECK ACCESS	Only current USA Swimming registered athletes, coaches, officials, and official meet staff are permitted on the pool deck. All non-athletes on the pool deck must produce proof of their valid USA Swimming registration when asked. Individuals without proof of a valid membership in USA Swimming will be removed from the pool deck and will be fined by New England Swimming of \$100 to the coach, and \$200 to the coach's club.
OFFICIALS	Officials that know they will be attending the meet are highly encouraged to email the Meet Referee, Ricky Martins , and let him know your level of certification, team, and sessions you will be available. Officials' meetings will be at least 30 minutes prior to the start of a session.
GENERAL	Hospitality will be available for all coaches, officials, and meet staff. Snacks and drinks will be passed around for meet volunteers. Both concessions and a swim shop vendor will be available on site.
